

SUMMER RIDING CAMP

A partnership with Horses Healing Humans (HHH), a full equestrian center located on Rt. 184 in Stonington. Join HHH for a week-long riding camp experience for ages 5-15. The camp provides a structured daily schedule that incorporates horsemanship, art and nature awareness with small group sessions. Parents or guardians drop off and pick up directly at the center. Lunch will be provided for the 10am to 2pm week-long program.

Each week enrolls a maximum of 6 participants (min 3).

New Schedule (as of 6/10/20)

Ages 5-9 yrs. old: July 20-24 or Aug 10-14

Ages 10-15 yrs. old: Aug 3-5 + Aug 17-24 + Aug 24-28

Fee: \$450/week, Residents & Non-Residents

Participants may register for 1, 2 or all 3 of the weeks for their age group.
